On behalf of the Susan B. Anthony List and over 800,000 Americans we represent across the country, I write to you in strong support of the Republican Motion to Recommit to H.R. 535 PFAS Action Act of 2019.

The Motion to Recommit ensures that the unborn are considered as part of potentially vulnerable populations when studying the effects of certain chemicals. A vote against the MTR is a vote against considering the safety of unborn children.

A strong bipartisan majority enacted similar language to protect unborn children in the Unborn Victims of Violence Act in 2004.

It should be common sense that Americans are concerned about the effects of chemicals on vulnerable unborn children.

Susan B. Anthony List will score in favor of this Motion to Recommit, but takes no position on H.R. 535, the underlying bill.
